**What to Bring**

- **Clothes:** T-shirts, shorts, modest swimsuit, 1 pair long pants, closed-toed shoes (no crocs; tennis shoes preferred), messy clothes for recreation, a sweatshirt or jacket for cool evenings
- **Towels** for showers and swimming and **linens** (sleeping bags recommended)
- **Toiletries:** the usual. In addition, hand soap and towels for washing hands in the dormitory bathrooms.
- **Bible and pen/pencil**
- **Sunscreen and bug repellent**
- **Water bottle:** This is essential. We are not providing paper cups for water breaks. Campers must bring a water bottle to fill and use throughout the day.
- **Flashlight**
- A lightweight **backpack** or **tote bag**
- Some **money** for the snack bar, the camp store, and the mission offering

**What Not to Bring**

- Prank items (e.g., shaving cream, water balloons)
- Illegal drugs, tobacco products, firearms, or alcohol. These are not tolerated at camp.
- Electronic Devices: cell phones, mp3 players, portable DVD players, etc., must be switched off at camp. This is to help campers focus on God, camp, relationships, and themselves.

**Dress Code**

*Campers should dress modestly and appropriately, according to their size and developmental stage, the entire week of camp.*

- **Swimsuits:** All swimsuits should be modest. Girls may wear a t-shirt over two-piece suits. If campers are wearing swimsuits during other activities, they should wear clothing over them.
- **Worship Dress:** Campers who lead worship (reading scripture, singing, praying, etc.) should wear jeans, slacks, long dresses/ skirts, or modest shorts to worship. Campers who do not lead on stage may dress according to the general dress code.
